

Day One: Sunday, July 9, 2023:

Tonight, enjoy excellent cuisine in the hotel's dining room. **(Dinner included)**



Day Two: Monday, July 10, 2023:

After breakfast we set out for Montreal. We meet our local guide for a morning of sightseeing. See the historic Old City, the scenic view of the City from Mt. Royal, University of Montreal, McGill University, Olympic Stadium, Sainte – Helene’s Island and many other historic landmarks.

This afternoon we will discover Montreal from the river as we set sail on a fascinating guided cruise on the St. Lawrence River. You’ll enjoy breathtaking views of downtown, learn more about Quebec’s metropolis and have the opportunity to soak it all in on the boat’s outdoor terraces.
